A comprehensive curriculum approved by the American Orff Schulwerk Association will be presented in these courses designed to help music teachers understand the rationale and sequence of the Orff pedagogy, further develop their own musicianship, and apply the pedagogy to the classroom.

Our workshops follow a spiraled approach where introductory experiences move through progressively more sophisticated instructional strategies. Musical composition and improvisation are focused on placing children’s learning needs in the forefront.

Classes will run from 8:30 a.m. until approximately 5:00 p.m. each weekday in Frasier Hall on the UNC Campus (10 days of class, no Saturday or Sunday classes).
